

# 25 Most Common Excel Shortcut Keys

<b>Serial No.</b>	<b>Shortcut Keys</b>	<b>Functions</b>
1.	<b>Ctrl + C</b>	Copies the content of a selected cell.
2.	<b>Ctrl + V</b>	Pastes contents from the clipboard.
3.	<b>Ctrl + X</b>	Cuts and copies the contents of a selected cell.
4.	<b>Ctrl + A</b>	Selects all the cells in a workbook.
5.	<b>Ctrl + F</b>	Opens the Find dialog box.
6.	<b>Ctrl + G</b>	Opens the Go To dialog box.
7.	<b>Ctrl + H</b>	Opens the Find and Replace dialog box.
8.	<b>Ctrl + K</b>	Inserts a hyperlink in a selected text.
9.	<b>Ctrl + L</b>	Opens the Create Table dialog box.
10.	<b>Ctrl + P</b>	Avails the Print window to print a worksheet.
11.	<b>Ctrl + W</b>	Closes the current workbook.
12.	<b>Ctrl + Z</b>	Reverses the last action.
13.	<b>Ctrl + 1</b>	Opens the Format Cells dialog box.
14.	<b>Ctrl + -</b>	Deletes the selected columns or rows.
15.	<b>Ctrl + Space</b>	Selects an entire column.
15.	<b>Shift + Space</b>	Selects an entire row.
16.	<b>Ctrl + Home</b>	Redirects to cell A1.
17.	<b>Alt</b>	Displays the access keys.
18.	<b>Tab</b>	Moves to the next cell.
19.	<b>F2</b>	Enables editing a cell.
20.	<b>Esc</b>	Cancels out an entry.

21.	<b>Enter</b>	Executes an entry in a cell and moves to the next cell.
22.	<b>Alt + Enter</b>	Starts a new line in the current cell.
23.	<b>F1</b>	Opens the Microsoft Excel help.
24.	<b>Ctrl + F4</b>	Closes Microsoft Excel.
25.	<b>Alt +F8</b>	Opens the Macro window.
